

**Washington Skeet Shooting Association
General Membership Meeting
Spokane Gun Club
July 27, 2007**

President Bob Miller opened the meeting at 6:32 PM.

There were approximately 25 WSSA members in attendance and 15 non-members.

Presidents Report – President Bob Miller reported that the 2008 state shoot would probably be awarded to the Lynden Shotgun Club as long as a suitable proposal is made at the upcoming advisory board/scheduling meeting. This meeting will be held in Moxee on September 29th. Originally tentatively scheduled for Bremerton, the president of the Bremerton Trap and Skeet Club called Bob and said they were going to pass on the 2008 state shoot at this time. Bob also mentioned the dinner time tomorrow night had been moved up to 6:30 PM from 7 PM.

Vice Presidents Report – Vice president Jerry Smith reported that he had audited the books and all was in order. Jerry also mentioned the jackpot shootoff tomorrow night and how it would be run.

Secretary Treasurers Report – Secretary Treasurer Norm Andersen reported that the current checkbook balance stands at \$4,042.77, the WSSA CD at \$7,187.70, the Hall of Fame CD at \$2,631.50 when it matures on May 26, 2008 and the WSSSF scholarship fund at \$20,558.16. He also gave an NSSA report that in 2006 approximately one third of members joining NSSA did not shoot a target and approximately one third did not renew the next year. Small shoot seen to be declining slightly while the large major shoots are up slightly. There are no nibbles regarding purchase of the NSSA home site in San Antonio. There are 240 entries for the U S Open in Albuquerque New Mexico. The 2007 Zone 7 shoot will be held in Bakersfield CA in two weeks. There are about 175 shooters signed up.

Old Business – There was no old business brought up.

New Business – Jason Parson mention trying to get a suitable date for the establishment of a major sponsored shoot in the Northwest. Thought to be a good idea by those present. **Motion by Jason Parson with a second by Bruce Jones to pursue and to try and find a suitable date for such a shoot. Motion carried, all in favor.** President Miller will work with Jason regarding putting a proposal together for the scheduling meeting September 29th.

RV Miller asked that the date of the state shoot be moved to the first weekend in August. It was pointed out that this date is one weekend before the traditional Zone 7 shoot date. The state shoot has been on the last weekend of July for over 20 years. **RV made a motion to this effect with a second by Roy Watanabe.** After discussion, RV rescinded his motion and Roy rescinded his second. This question will be on the meeting agenda at Moxee September 29th.

There being no further new business before the general membership, **Motion by Marc Alden with a second by Erv Hume to adjourn. Motion carried, all in favor.**

The 2007 WSSA general membership meeting was adjourned at 7:04 PM.
