



Washington State Skeet Scholarship Fund

“Shooters Aiming For Higher Education”



Selection Criteria

Scholarships may be awarded before the individual enters an accredited institution of higher learning or an accredited trade school of higher learning. To receive the scholarship the recipient must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a resident of the state of Washington for a period of three (3) years previous to application.
2. Maintain or have maintained a 3.0 or higher grade point average in high school.
3. Individuals may qualify by:
 - (a) Having shot at least an average of 500 registered target per year for a period of three (3) years or
 - (b) Having been a qualified referee for a period of three years refereeing a minimum of 2000 targets per year.
4. Show sportsmanship, service to skeet (refereeing, trap help, etc), service to the community (boy/girl scouts, etc) or other activities that exemplifies sportsmanship.
5. Must be at least in their sophomore year of high school to make application.
6. Scholarships will be awarded to applicants based on the availability of funds with preference given to new first time applicants.
7. Fill out and submit a WSSF scholarship application each time applying for a scholarship.
